Course Curriculum:

Big Idea 1: Homeostasis is maintained through physiological processes

• Biomolecules; metabolism; enzymes; feedback loops; cell membrane transport

Big Idea 2: Gene Expression, through protein synthesis is an interaction between genes and the environments

• DNA; gene expression; proteins and their relationship to cell structure and function; genomics and biotechnology

Big Idea 3: Organs Systems have complex interrelationships to maintain homeostasis

• Micro to Macro organization; organ systems interdependence; maintenance of homeostasis; lifestyle effects on human health; holistic approaches; disease as an imbalance in homeostasis
